

- Buy your books from local, independent bookstores. This one seems like a nobrainer, but we understand sometimes it's easier to hop online and load up your cart on other bookseller sites. So many local stores now have similar options and pricing and are just as easy to purchase from as larger online retailers. Even during these times of social distancing, you can purchase gift cards, ebooks, and even get physical books shipped from many of your local stores.
- Don't have a book you're in the market for at the moment? You can also make a
 donation to your local store. Check out this <u>Publisher's Weekly</u> article with a list of
 stores with current GoFundMe campaigns.
- Like and share their posts as well as tag them whenever you post a book from their

- store (also use Instagram's location field to list a store's location).
- Use hashtags like #indiebookstores #saveindiebookstores and #localbookstore as well as hashtagging your store's name to allow others to find similar posts.
- If you're in the U.S., make sure to follow your regional independent bookseller association on social media to stay up to date on news as well as new releases.
