

Baby Boomer Retirement said Stephanie Raffelock's new book is great for those looking to "regain a fresh perspective on your life."



Ninja author Tori Eldridge is one of 25 authors talking social distancing in this roundup for <u>Hasty Book List</u>.



<u>Forking Podcast</u> for an uninterrupted adult conversation with hosts Celeste and Magen.




Michael C. Bland hopped on <u>Citywide</u>
